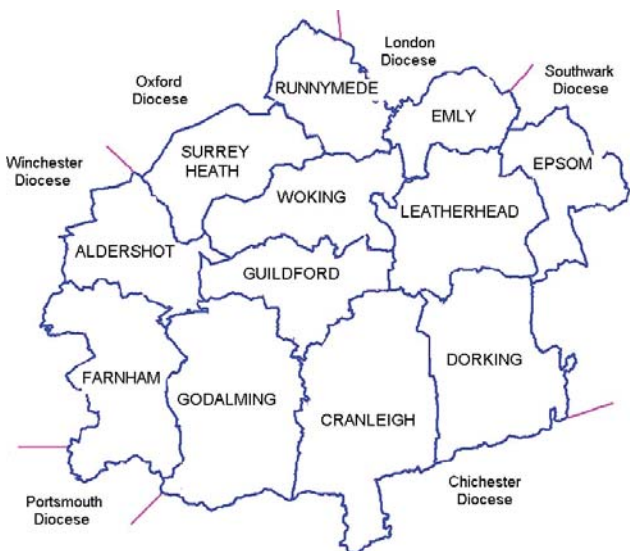


Diocese of Guildford
