joy to all the people.' Luke 2:10

You may choose to create artwork to illustrate this Bible verse or more generally on the theme of Jesus bringing joy to the world. You could create artwork to show messages of joy being brought to the world by Jesus, by the angels, or the joy people bring to one another. You may like to show the joy that your school brings to your community. We would like cathedral

visitors to appreciate how thoughtful the pupils are, and to be encouraged to recognise that even in the darkest times God brings joy. One of the unique features of this exhibition is having artwork created by pupils of all ages from nursery to sixth form.

We very much hope that your school will take part.



Practical details.

• Please let me know if you want to take part by Friday 7th November on this form. Or scan this QR code.



- The artwork needs to have a solid base so that it can be free standing and robust enough for us to move without bits falling off!
- Artwork should be between 50cm and 150cm tall.
- If possible, please provide an explanation of your art, the visitors appreciate the children's thinking.
- The virgers are not able to turn battery lights on and off every day, so please don't waste your funds by using them in your artwork.
- Sticky tape often dries out due to the underfloor heating! Other fixings last longer!
- Art needs to be delivered to the cathedral between Saturday 22nd and Friday 28th November. (we will send details about drop off to the address you give us on your registration form)
- Art will be on display from Sunday 30th November 2025 to Monday 2nd February 2026.
- Your school name must be clearly displayed, and firmly attached, to the front of each piece.
- Art must be collected by Friday 20th February 2026.
