


## Resources for Reflective Activities



You may wish to set up a prayer space, reflective area or Easter trail for pupils to use as part of your ExploRE Easter day. You could set these up inside school, in the school grounds, in the local church or in the churchyard. These activities are ideal to create in partnership with your local church community, such as your local clergy, an assembly team, or an open the Book Team.

### Prayer Spaces in Schools [Prayer Spaces In Schools](#)



Prayer Spaces in Schools have several prayer activities that focus on Easter. You may wish to include some that are not part of the Easter set such as the bubble tube or fizzy forgiveness. If you are creating a prayer space, we would recommend at least 6 activities but no more than 10.

Go to the Resources tab, then Prayer Activities. Type Easter into the search box. This then opens all the Easter prayer activities. You can further refine your search by age group or by the language of spiritual relationships that we use in our diocesan framework.

If you click on the Activity Sets tab you will find 7 activities for Easter at School.
