God of all comfort, we pray for those that we know who are sick or in need of healing. We lift before you **xxxxxx** May they know your presence, your comfort, and your healing touch. **Lord, in your mercy, hear our prayer.**

God of peace, we pray for those who mourn, and for all who are bereaved. We especially hold in our hearts the families and friends of **xxxxx**, who have recently died. May they be comforted by your love and strengthened by your peace.
