Weaving a Journey Through Lent – by Rachel Nichols

This a hard copy book available second hand online

This book includes 28 assemblies for each school day in Lent. They cover a range of gospel events including the story of the resurrection, which approaches the death of Jesus in a sensitive and appropriate way for primary-aged children.

The best bit is that you weave a different colour wool around a cross to fit each assembly. This creates a great centrepiece.

Ash Wednesday

Many schools like to mark the start of Lent with a special collective worship or church service on Ash Wednesday. Each year a few schools get in touch to ask our advice about children being marked with an ash cross on their forehead as part of this service. In an adult service this would always be optional.

Our view is that schools should have parental permission for this to be done, the children opting in without their parents' agreement is not sufficient permission.

Ash Wednesday Service - for ash crosses

At Send Primary School last year they had an Ash Wednesday service in which they laid a long white sheet down the aisle of the church. The members of the worship team held

bowls of ashes and if the pupils wished to do so they dipped their fingers in to the ash and made a cross on the white sheet.
