- Be trained in the basic maintenance of hearing aids to become 'hearing champions'
- Offer these simple maintenance sessions, at existing church social events e.g. coffee mornings, lunches, afternoon teas

Hearing Champions Training will include:

- Checking the hearing aid is working
- Replacing the battery, battery life
- Re-tubing
- Outline of audiology pathways in your area



To be an effective Hearing Champion you will need good eyesight and good manual dexterity.
